

Assisting customers with special hardship

Do you have a financial hardship due to job loss, illness, military deployment, disability, or as a senior citizen? If so, you may be eligible for assistance through ComEd's Residential Special Hardship program. Income-eligible, residential customers can apply once every 3 years for grants of up to \$500 based on need and availability of program funds.

Qualifications

This fund applies to residential customers with household incomes up to 200% of the federal poverty level (\$44,100 for a family of four) who identify a hardship issue — including documented medical, military, senior, or disability hardships among others.
